### Background

Founded in 1976 by renowned Viennese conductor and violinist, Giora Bernstein, the Colorado Music Festival (CMF) is one of the foremost summer music festivals in the world. Drawing musicians from many of North America's finest symphony orchestras, including the Minnesota, Detroit, Montreal, Toronto, Oregon, Charlotte, and Phoenix symphonies, CMF annually presents nearly thirty orchestral, chamber music and educational performances in and around Boulder. From 2001–2013, CMF was led by Music Director Laureate Michael Christie. Christie is credited with elevating the quality of the orchestra and galvanizing audiences through performances of the highest level. Following Christie's departure in 2013, the organization appointed celebrated Canadian conductor Jean-Marie Zeitouni as its third Music Director.
