# PRIVATE LESSONS

Private lessons are the core of our program at the RMCMA. Weekly private lessons can be arranged for 30, 45, or 60 minutes. For some instruments, it is possible to arrange semiprivate lessons through consultation with the Student Services Office. Lessons may begin at any time during the year. It is the student's responsibility to have an instrument; the Registrar can help advise students towards rental options. If you are new to private lessons at RMCMA, a paid, three-week trial lesson period is offered to insure the student is well matched with his/her instructor.

Our instructors are a diverse group of skilled, dedicated music educators and professional performers who share a strong belief in the pure joy of making music. They hold degrees from leading university and conservatory programs throughout the country and abroad, and are experienced in working with students of all ages and abilities.
