The CMA provides quality, creative music-making opportunities to over 500 students each week and is a full member of the National Guild for Community Arts Education. Our vision is "Music for All... For Life!" The CMA is located in the heart of downtown Lafayette and features 12 newly renovated teaching studios, a classroom, and two performance spaces, Founders Hall and Grimes Recital Hall.

Qualifications: Minimum of bachelor's degree in music performance and/or education. The ideal candidate will be a passionate, expert teacher with several years of teaching experience at many levels and in many settings, including group classes. S/He will be a warm and creative instructor who is excited to teach in and be part of a larger musical community and believes in the mission and vision of the organization. *We expect to attract students to build a studio at the Center. However, the initial need is for five lessons at two different public schools in Lafayette. One is scheduled for Mondays, 2:40-3:40. The other will be 3:45-5:15 and can be arranged for Tuesdays, Wednesdays or Thursdays.*

Responsibilities may include but are not limited to:

- Teach 30, 45, and 60 minute private lesson
- Teach 45 and 60 minute group lessons
- Select developmentally appropriate repertoire for students within established goals
- Encourage and prepare students for recitals
- Assist administration in attracting new students
- Performing in faculty recitals and outreach events and attend other events when possible
- Participate in Faculty Meetings (currently once per term)
- Communicate effectively with administrative personnel
- Complete attendance records and pay sheets

CMA responsibilities may include but are not limited to:

- Marketing and outreach activities to attract new students
- Schedule lessons within your desired framework
- Bill students and collect payments
- Provide appropriate teaching studio and equipment
- Monthly paycheck commensurate with education and experience
